The Lead & Copper Rule Revisions (LCRR) requires water systems to prepare & maintain an inventory of service line materials. Initial inventories are required to be submitted to state primacy agencies by October 16, 2024.

- The City of Rensselaer is required to notify each customer with lead service lines, galvanized service lines, or any unknown service lines within 30 days of October 16, 2024.
