## **Entry Level Laborer – Sanitation Department**

The City of Rensselaer Sanitation Department is seeking a qualified candidate for the position of entry level laborer. This is a full-time position and will require the candidate to work occasional overtime. The candidate must live within 15 miles of the City of Rensselaer.

Applicant must have a minimum of a high school diploma or equivalent and be required to pass a physical & drug screen. Successful candidate must possess a valid driver's license.

## General Responsibilities include but not limited to:

- Drive truck and pull trailer following the designated trash/recycling route within municipality to pick up & load garbage/recyclable material onto truck.
- Dismount garbage trucks to collect garbage and remount trucks to ride to the next collection point.
- Operate automated/semiautomated hoisting devices that raise refuse & recycling and dump contents into truck bodies.
- Transport material to respective disposal areas.
- Assists in unloading recycling trailer and sorting materials
- Operating forklift, light machinery and any other duties assigned
